

2021: Rep. Zack Stephenson's (District 35, Coon Rapids) House File 2366 calls for the termination of e-pull tab games that "display or simulate any other form of gambling, entertainment, slot machines, electronic video lotteries, or video games of chance."

Rep. Zack Stephenson tells the Star Tribune that he continues to believe it would be "wonderful" to ELIMINATE charitable gambling e-pull tabs.

2023-2024: Rep. Zack Stephenson sponsors House File 2000, a tribal only sports betting bill that would give tribes another **MONOPOLY** in gaming.

2023: Rep. Zack Stephenson votes for House File 1938 which makes all current e-pull tab games illegal. The bill becomes law.

2023-2024: **Rep. Zack Stephenson** sponsors a bill that becomes law allowing Minnesota's tribal nations to start selling marijuana before the rest of the state's businesses are up and running. He backs giving "social equity" applicants such as tribes preference in Minnesota's new marijuana marketplace in addition to prior convicted felons.

2024: Rep. Zack Stephenson sponsors House File 5274, a bill that took direct aim at the state's racetracks' "card playing and pari-mutuel betting." The bill sought to eliminate games and features being used by the tracks for years.

2024: Rep. Zack Stephenson sponsors Senate File 2219, a standalone bill that banned new technology approved by the Minnesota Racing Commission (MRC), a key component in keeping the horse racing industry viable in the state. The bill becomes law.
